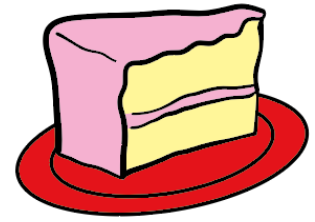


Idioms
